127th Street from Metcalf Avenue to Nall Street is a one-mile section that required improvement due to the expanding population of Overland Park. This highly traveled road section provides a route to the South Creek Business Park from residential neighborhoods to the east. BHC RHODES provided survey and engineering design for the improvements which consisted of reconstructing the existing two-lane roadway to a divided four-lane thoroughfare section and adding dual southbound left turn lanes on Metcalf Avenue. The project also included sidewalks (with ADA ramp designs) that connect to the Tomahawk Creek trail system, landscaping enhancements, storm sewer design, street lighting, pavement and guard rail replacement, traffic signal modifications, utility coordination, and extensive public involvement.
