The residents of 38th and Jefferson near Westport in Overland Park petitioned the City for PIAC funds to correct the issue of ponding water in the streets during specific rain events. The area was served by a combined sanitary and storm sewer system, which made the new drainage improvements complicated due to location and capacity issues. BHC RHODES provided design improvements that eliminated ponding of water and enhanced the appearance of the intersection while minimizing disturbance of the adjacent properties. This project was completed successfully on an accelerated design schedule under the City's budget.
