The 78th Street improvements in Kansas City, Kansas include the widening of the existing 4-lane undivided roadway to a 5-lane divided section, realignment of the Tauromee intersection to improve the traffic flow, and evaluation of improvements to the I-70 interchange. Construction is scheduled for 2010 and will be administered by KDOT Bureau of Local Projects. BHC RHODES provided an extensive traffic study and a detailed survey of the corridor. Significant work was done to engage the public and utilities along 78th Street to coordinate property acquisition and utility relocations required for roadway widening of 78th Street. The project also included reconstruction for 1,800 feet of Tauromee Avenue west of 78th Street and realignment plans for Tauromee east of 78th Street.
