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The City of Lenexa, Kansas found improvements were needed to manage traffic on the 1.5 mile dirt road families took to access Lake Lenexa and its park area. BHC RHODES was called to provide construction staking and construction inspection of those improvements. The dirt road had a narrow wooden bridge with a weight limit of only 10 tons. It was transformed into an asphalt paved, two-lane road with four round-a-bouts. Improvements also included a new 350 ft. haunched slab bridge structure with two 12 ft. driving lanes and sidewalks on both sides which connect to the hiking and bike paths. Our inspection included grading, paving, curb and gutter, storm drainage facilities, roundabouts, a 350 foot concrete haunched slab bridge, street lighting, sidewalks, and water quality amenities.
