When the Lenexa City Council voted to accelerate Santa Fe Trail Drive reconstruction, the City Engineer contacted BHC RHODES to help make it happen. The project involved total replacement of all curb, gutter, pavement, and storm water structure tops on Santa Fe Trail Drive from Summit to Noland Road. Total reconstruction of the adjacent 90-stall parking lot at Old Town Lenexa was added to the project. BHC RHODES delivered preliminary plans in four weeks and worked closely with City staff to expedite construction in fall 2008. Construction was completed only 7 months after BHC RHODES received the notice to proceed. Unique aspects included: stamped concrete intersection, storm water treatment device, railroad coordination, construction phasing to avoid downtown festivals, and fast track delivery.
